## Bolton Urges Strong Response From U.N.

**UNITED NATIONS** - The U.N. Security Council must send a "strong and unanimous signal" that North Korea's missile test-launch was unacceptable, U.S. Ambassador John Bolton said Wednesday. Bolton made the remarks while heading into an emergency Security Council meeting where diplomats were to discuss a draft Japanese resolution that would likely condemn the North Korean missile tests.

He called the launches a very serious matter but stressed that the council would proceed in a "calm and deliberate fashion."

"We hope we have a strong and unanimous signal from the council that this kind of behavior is unacceptable," Bolton said.
